

# The 10th International Conference on Teaching Chinese as a Second Language: Discipline Formation and Development

## The 1st Announcement

#### **1.** Purpose of the Conference

Responding to new challenges and opportunities arising from recent global developments in international Chinese language education, the Conference will focus on the application of digital humanities, artificial intelligence, integrated education, and multimodal, diverse teaching methods in international Chinese language teaching. It will explore theoretical innovations, research advancements, and innovative teaching models and methods in international Chinese language education, promoting the discipline formation and development. The Conference will utilize the resources and expertise of language education in the Hong Kong region and unite scholars from the Mainland, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and Macau to address core issues in the development of international Chinese education through keynote speeches, expert forums, and paper presentations. The aim is to provide a robust platform for experts and peers in international Chinese language education from around the world to exchange ideas.

#### 6. Submission Guidelines

- 1. Abstracts must align with the Conference's scope and topics.
- 2. Abstracts must not have been published in any form previously. Full papers are not required.
- 3. Submission includes the paper title, three to five keywords, and a 400-600 word abstract (in either Chinese or English), and selection of a topic group.
- 4. Accepted presenters must deliver a 15-20 minute oral presentation and participate in a discussion session.
- 5. Each presenter may present only one paper as the first author. If more than one first-author abstract is accepted, the presenter must select one and inform the Secretariat at the time of registration fee payment.
- 6. All abstracts will undergo anonymous peer review, and the results will be notified via email.
- 7. All presenters must pay the registration fee by the deadline to confirm their attendance.
  - Authors participating in group presentations but not attending the Conference are not required to pay the registration fee.
- 8. The Conference Organizing Committee reserves the final decision on abstract submissions.

## 7. Payment Arrangements

- 1. Participants registering as "students" must provide valid proof (e.g., student ID) to the Conference Secretariat for verification.
- 2. There will be no refund service for the Conference; once the registration fee is paid, no refund requests will be accepted.
